In a community of showplaces, this 27-acre estate with a beautiful Georgian residence of 19 rooms is the perfect setting for the traditional hospitality of Long Island's North Shore. Convenient to fine clubs, beaches and excellent schools, it is just 22 miles from midtown Manhattan.

Designed by architect Bradley Delahanty, the house is beautifully proportioned. English ivy and wisteria climb its whitewashed brick facade, enhancing its mellow charm. Towering oaks, elms, beeches and pines shade the residence, which is surrounded by inviting terraces and smooth lawns. Hundreds of dogwood and fruit trees and rhododendron bushes furnish a profusion of blooms in the spring. The landscaping, simple but tremendously effective, requires a minimum of care.

Oriented around a large center hall with a graceful spiral stairway, there are six rooms on the first floor. Almost all open to terraces, and command delightful views. In the large living room, three immense Palladian windows overlook a terrace and the distant countryside. A fine

wrought-iron stairway leads to a balcony in the huge, magnificently paneled 2-story library, which has a marble fireplace and extensive rows of built-in bookcases. A restful study with oakpaneled walls and a fireplace adjoins the library and opens to a porch with hand-hewn beams. A square hall with a fireplace opens on another terrace and separates the living room from the dining room. A huge picture window, French doors to a terrace, and a fireplace are among the attractive features of an informal sitting room. A big, well-planned kitchen, pantries, refrigeration and maintenance rooms complete the first floor.

On the second floor, reached by several stairways, there are five spacious bedrooms, each with a well-appointed private bath and lavish closet space. A separate wing contains the servants' rooms and two baths.

This North Shore estate with its superbly appointed residence, delightful terraces and picturesque acreage is an ideal home for those who entertain often, yet value seclusion in an atmosphere of quiet charm.
